

Does you child have a missing testicles in scrotum?




Operating before the age of 9 months prevents complications





Does your child have abnormal bulge while crying?




Hernia surgery is safe even in newborns





Does your baby have an abnormally large head?




Timely operation can prevent future complications

(benign vascular tumor)




Good cosmetic outcome depends upon a proper management






Is your boy passing urine from a hole underneath?

Does your baby have swelling over spine?




Timely operation can prevent future complications





Does your child have problems due to tight foreskin?




Timely operation can prevent future complications






Does your child have lump abdomen?
